Assignment Description:

1. First of all, you need to create a quote that should sound like it is meant to give good advice, or be deep, but is actually bad advice.
2. Secondly, to support your quote, you will create a piece of art that expresses that quote artistically.

It's like an adventure, I suppose, if you are looking forward to it, riding a scandal would be a good example of conflict]</p> <p>She then realized that he was already with someone, but she believed in the power of the love she had for him.</p> <p>[She made her mind up as a young girl, remember? A little thing like someone else in his life won't stop their love, this is a point of conflict, too]</p> <p>She herself had lovers and he had to wait and be patient, and they may have had tough times, but in the end their love is for the long haul, not for the short-term issues they were overcoming.</p> <p>[Is she cheating on him? Do they have tough times? She seems to believe that the end justifies the means to the dream of their love. Resolution of the story can be through this process]</p>
