<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Cool Quote(s)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Because it's important to the character (development of character or plot)</li> <li>• Because it uses and is a good example of a literary device (you must explain which device it is and why it is this LD).</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>The Historian</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What era/year/setting are we in?</li> <li>• What does that tell you about the setting, culture, story etc</li> <li>• How might this affect/influence our character</li> </ul> <p><small>(This may change as the character gets older/story progresses)</small></p>	<p>This is your personal response to what you have just read. This is informal expression about how you feel about the characters, the content, the story, and/or the writing style.</p> <p>It's okay if you like it or you don't, but make sure to express why. Try to give examples and explain your statements.</p> <p>You can also go into further depth with the information you have collected on the left.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Vocabulary</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Word you are unfamiliar with either because it's new or because the context in which it was used is new.</li> <li>• Quote the sentence it's used in</li> <li>• Define the word (<b>in your own words</b>)</li> <li>• What chapter/page is it in/on</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Prediction</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Completed before you read</li> <li>• Completed with specific details</li> <li>• Should be completed individually (should not match anyone of your group's predictions )</li> </ul>
