Assignment Synopsis:

This is a verbal assignment that promotes analyzing articles, comparing these articles and when looking at the questions below, highlighting anything that can support these articles as connected. In class we will have you choose three of the five questions below and find anything you can use from the articles to comment effectively on these questions in an informed manner.

What to do:

1. Read the articles, paying attention to major themes, issues, and such.
2. Read the questions below and choose three of the five to focus on and find anything in the articles that might be good to mention to support your commentary, or drive the answers to the questions. Highlight those parts and number them the same as the question they connect to.
3. When we start on the questions, if you have chosen that one, volunteer your information, using the articles as your source.

Questions:

1. Why does Nazi Germany’s view of North America matter to us now?
2. Can we look at Hitler as a joke today?
3. How should the Jews feel about all this?
4. How can talking about history help us do better in the future?
5. What emotion underlies both of these pieces of evidence?
